# YALE UNIVERSITY INSTRUCTIONS FOR GRADUATING SENIORS

A list of late charges from the Bursar's Office will be posted at the Dean's office, and all obligations to the Bursar must be discharged by Monday, June 8, at 4:00 P.M. if the candidate is to receive his diploma with his class. All books taken from the libraries must be returned on or before June 8.

## Baccalaureate, 11 A.M., Sunday, June 14, 1964 - Woolsey Hall

Graduating seniors assemble in the courtyards of their colleges at 10:10 A.M. and form in procession as directed by the Faculty Marshals. Academic costume will be worn over <u>dark suits</u> with <u>dark shoes</u>. Smoking is not permitted in the procession. Cameras may not be carried.

In case of heavy rain the procession will be formed at 10:30 in the University Dining Hall.

In Woolsey Hall candidates remain standing, with caps on, until the President and Faculty are seated. Then they remove caps and are seated. They rise, without caps, at the close of the Baccalaureate Address when the President says: "Gentlemen of the graduating class . . . "

At the conclusion of the service, the candidates, with caps on, follow their Marshals out of the Hall.

### Class Day, 3 P.M., Sunday, June 14, 1964 - Old Campus

The class assembles on the Cross Campus between Berkeley College and William L. Harkness Hall and Calhoun College in cap and gown at 2:30. The Class Day Committee and speakers, followed by the Class Council, will lead the Class to the Old Campus in columns of four, beginning at 2:45. They will cross Elm St. to the sidewalk behind Durfee Hall, move down the sidewalk to College St., and along the College St. sidewalk to Phelps Archway. Class pipes and programs will be distributed there. The members of the Class will have seats reserved for them in front of the platform. In the event of rain, exercises will be held in Woolsey Hall. The procession will be omitted and seniors should be in their seats at 2:45.

## Commencement, 10:30 A.M., Monday, June 15, 1964 - Old Campus

Graduating seniors assemble in the courtyards of their colleges at 9:30 A.M. Unaffiliated seniors will be assigned to a college. Smoking is not permitted in the procession. Cameras may not be carried.

In case of heavy rain the outdoor procession is omitted, and the candidates go directly to the Ingalls Rink, where they should be in their seats by 10:15 A.M. Sections will be marked by colleges. At the conclusion of the exercises Faculty Marshals will lead their colleges in formation out of the building. They may disperse when they are at a sufficient distance from the Rink.

During the ceremony when the Dean says: "I have the honor to present candidates for the degree of Bachelor of Arts (or Science, or Engineering) .... in number," the candidates concerned rise and put on their caps at the word number.

When all candidates for the baccalaureate degree are standing, the President confers the degree "as designated by the Dean." Then student marshals representing each college come forward and receive diplomas for the Seniors affiliated with that college. As the student marshals return to their places, all candidates remove caps and sit down.

After the benediction the graduates remain standing until the President and Faculty have left the platform. They then follow their marshals back to the colleges.
